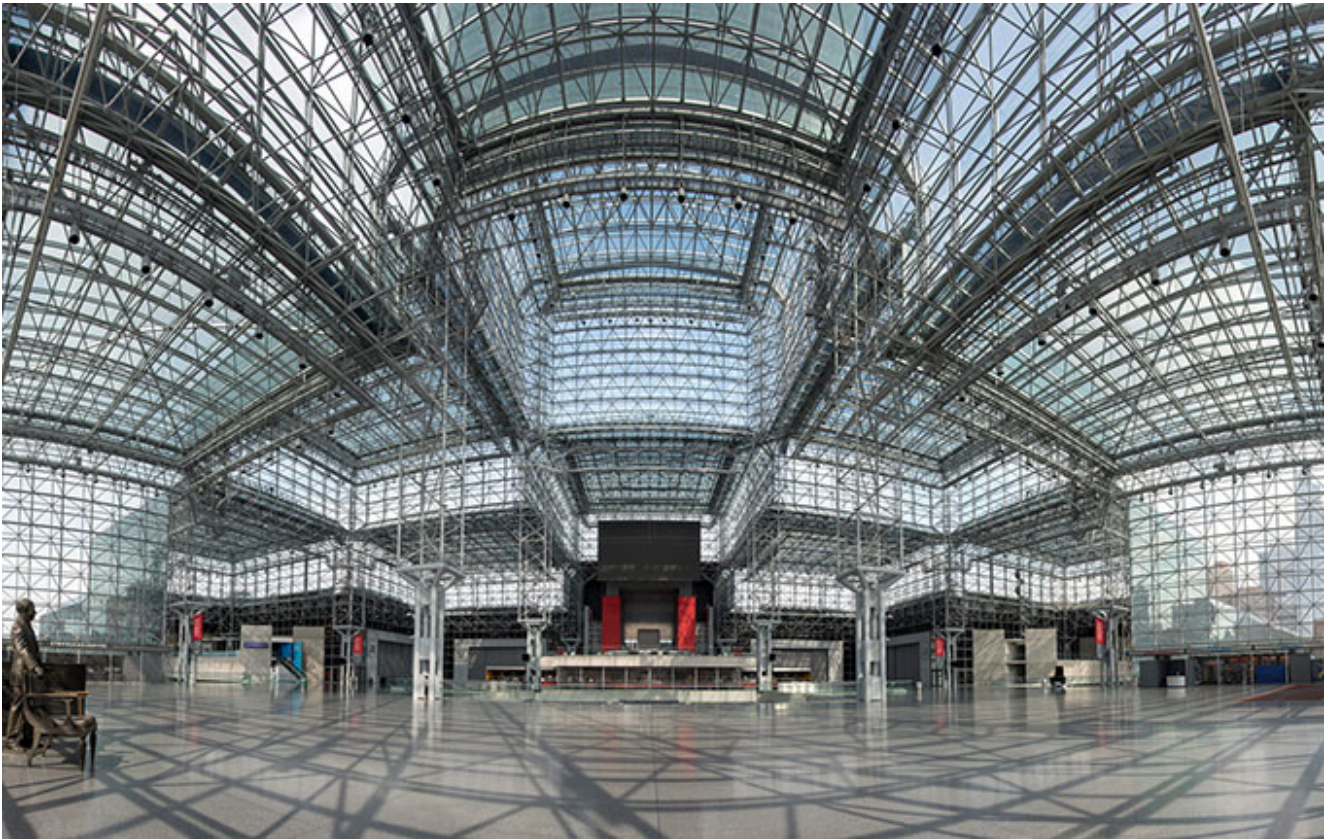

Javits Center Reno Featured at AIA Conference

The renovation and revitalization of the Javits Center will be featured in a discussion at the American Institute of Architects (AIA) Conference on Architecture in June at the convention center. Featuring a panel of experts, the session, which is part of the conference's continuing education credit program, will examine the history of the building and the impact of its renovation on the building itself and the surrounding environment.
